- Returning volunteers must reapply every year; new volunteers need to apply as well.

Current Events & Fundraisers

- Banner Fundraiser (thru 9/12): Businesses can sponsor car line banners.
- Spirit Wear (thru 9/15): We have a new design incorporating our theme; order forms sent home.
- Give Back Nights- usually a dinner or shopping event from 5-8 pm where a percentage of sales goes to LPE:

 - Looking to host monthly events businesses or contacts welcome!

Upcoming Events & Programs

- LPE Night at NHS: October 3 each child will get one ticket sent home; families can purchase the rest.
- Charleston Wrap Fundraiser: October 1–28 Fall's biggest fundraiser; it's a catalog fundraiser, but cash donations are accepted)
- **Penny Wars for Movie Night:** October 1–31- give a chance for the kids to vote on the movie while raising funds.
- **Pumpkin Sales:** October 1–31; pumpkins are \$3 and the kids can decorate for display at the Vocabulary Parade.







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Future Events

- Vocabulary Parade (10/31): Annual parade where kids can dress up based on grade level vocabulary options (e.g. nouns, verbs, compound words, idioms)
 - Costume donations needed drop off at the front office.
- Movie Night (11/7):
 - \$5 ticket includes popcorn; pizza and drinks sold separately; scholarship applicable
 - Movie suggestions welcome
 - Students can vote for the movie through Penny Wars.
- Thanksgiving Feast: November 20 annual Thanksgiving meal served during lunch
- Candy Cane Sales: December 1–5- fundraiser to support 5th grade
- Holiday House: December 9–12
 - Kids shop for gifts for families; items are affordable and non-religious.
 - Preview days included. Many volunteers needed (Sign-Up Genius to come).

Biggest Fundraiser - Walk-A-Thon (2/28/26)

- Largest event of the year- includes a walk through the zoo, courtyard games and activities and a silent auction. Allison showed everyone a Walk-A-Thon shirt and how the sponsors are on the back.
- Seeking sponsors and silent auction items; please start reaching out early.
- Walk-A-Thon T-shirts and sponsorships already in progress, which are included in the banner fundraiser.

- **Donations:** Time, money, or items—everything helps.
- Teacher Appreciation (May): Donate to individual teachers or the entire staff.

 - Volunteer interest forms going out soon.
 - Monthly emails will include details.
- Last Day of School Party: Not PTO-sponsored but well-loved Alex will help coordinate again. Tracey said we will still reschedule beginning of the year party, which was rained out.
