2. Principal's Report - Mrs. Maya

- Mrs. Maya announced a new parent-only informational event in November ("Panther Preview") for out-of-zone preschool/private school parents to explore LPE before Kindergarten Round-Up in April. All grade levels are welcome, not just kindergarten.
 - Goal: Provide a preview of the campus—not to recruit, but to inform parents making school decisions.
 - Event will be promoted in the Wednesday email blast.
 - LPE families already planning to attend next year, or already with a child at LPE are asked **not** to attend.
- Encouraged members to share event information with interested families.









3. Treasurer's Report – Ilisa Krich

- Car Line Banners: Record-breaking success raised over \$20,000, far exceeding expectations (initial guess was \$5,000).
 - Many new donors participated.
 - Members encouraged to thank businesses they use for supporting the program.
- Walk-A-Thon (WAT): Sponsorship goal for T-shirt sponsors already met; additional funds are surplus.
- Charleston Wrap: Raised \$3900 so far, plus Venmo, cash and check donations from option B of fundraiser; goal is \$5,000. Continued promotion encouraged.
- Pumpkin Sales: Sold out.
- Spirit Wear: Profitable this year, which it's usually not.
- Overall: Financial performance significantly stronger than last year
